The travelling book fair is about all next week. Due to social distancing measures please look at which day you and your child can view and purchase books.

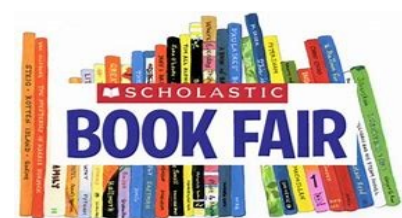
