Dear parents,

I am writing to you as promised regarding the proposed changes to uniform. First of all I would like to thank you for all your feedback. I received a number of emails, but also am aware that my heads of schools and I also received many more informal comments at drop off and pick up.

A large number of parents are in support of the active uniform and can see what we as schools are trying to achieve but there is a powerful voice from those parents who wish the children to retain a traditional uniform. I have therefore discussed this issue again with leaders and governors and have decided upon a compromise.

From September 2021, the Aspire schools will have an active uniform which CAN be worn all day every day. However for those parents who wish their child/ren to wear a traditional uniform this can be worn on the days that they are not involved in a PE lesson or active PE after school club. Active uniforms will still need to be worn on PE days by all children.

Uniforms can not be mixed and matched so if you would like your child/ren to wear the traditional uniform then you will also need to purchase an active uniform.

We ask you wherever possible to purchase the items from the supplier as not only are these logoed but also of the appropriate quality. If this is not possible we ask you to at least purchase the hoodie/ sweatshirt that then can be worn with plain white t-shirts and black bottoms. Leggings if worn as part of the active uniform should be plain black sports/ gym leggings.

The change of colour is staying as set out in my previous letter, so that each aspire school has its own identity within aspire. Kingswood will from September wear bottle green, Leeds and Broomfield - burgundy, Platts Heath - purple and Ulcombe - royal blue.

We have also taken on board the suggestions regarding a zip up version of the hoodie and this will be an option, as well as the over the head version as part of the active uniform. Please see the table below for the options.
