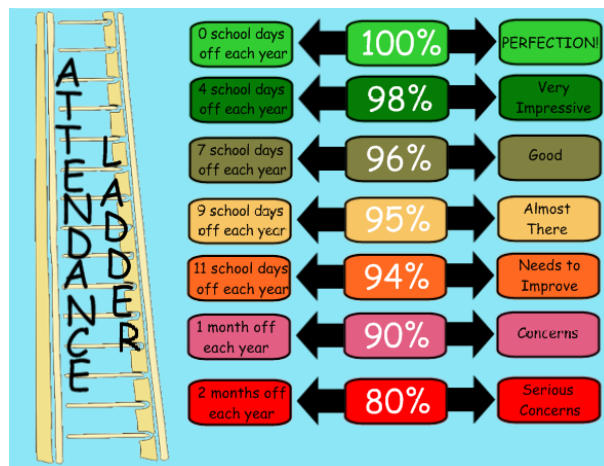
School success starts
