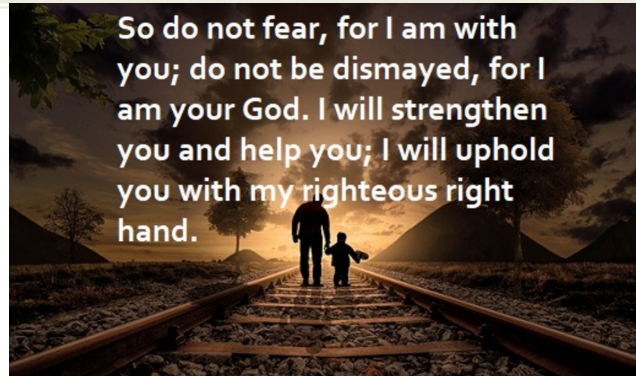

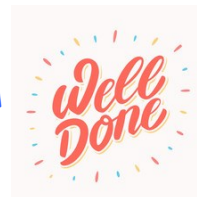


Car Parking

11th October - Homework club at lunch time from 12:45 to support anyone who would like to complete some of their homework challenges in school.

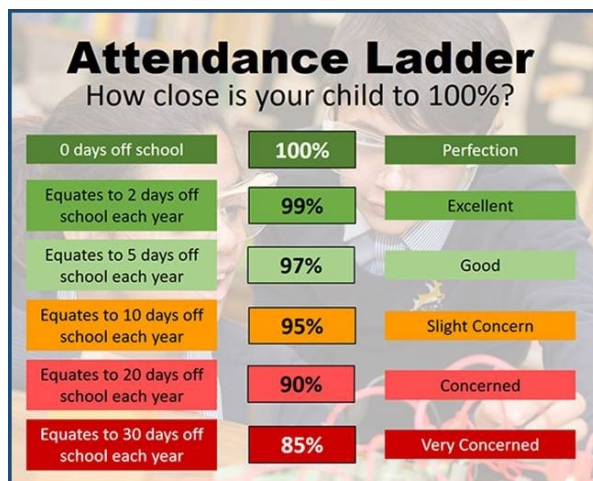
