This week the children have enjoyed getting stuck into their learning.

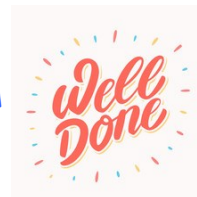


Car Parking

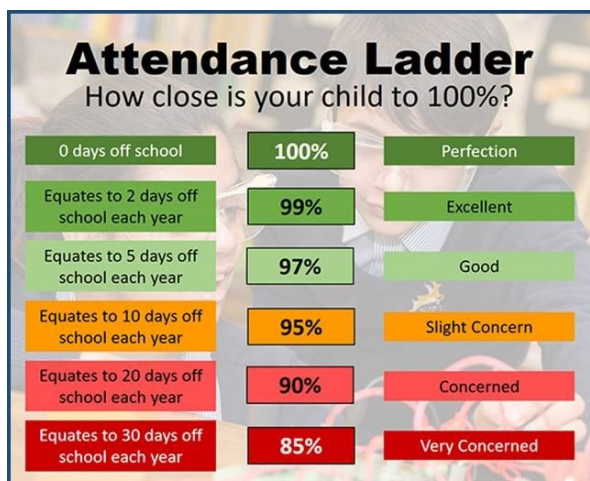
