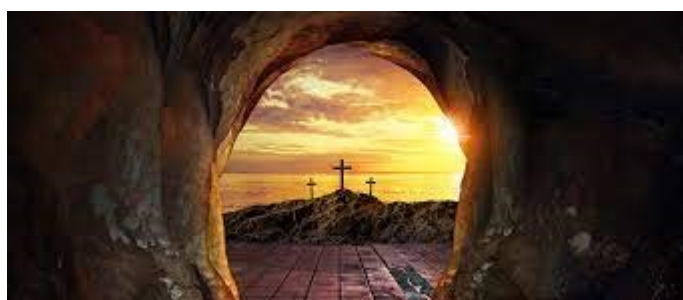

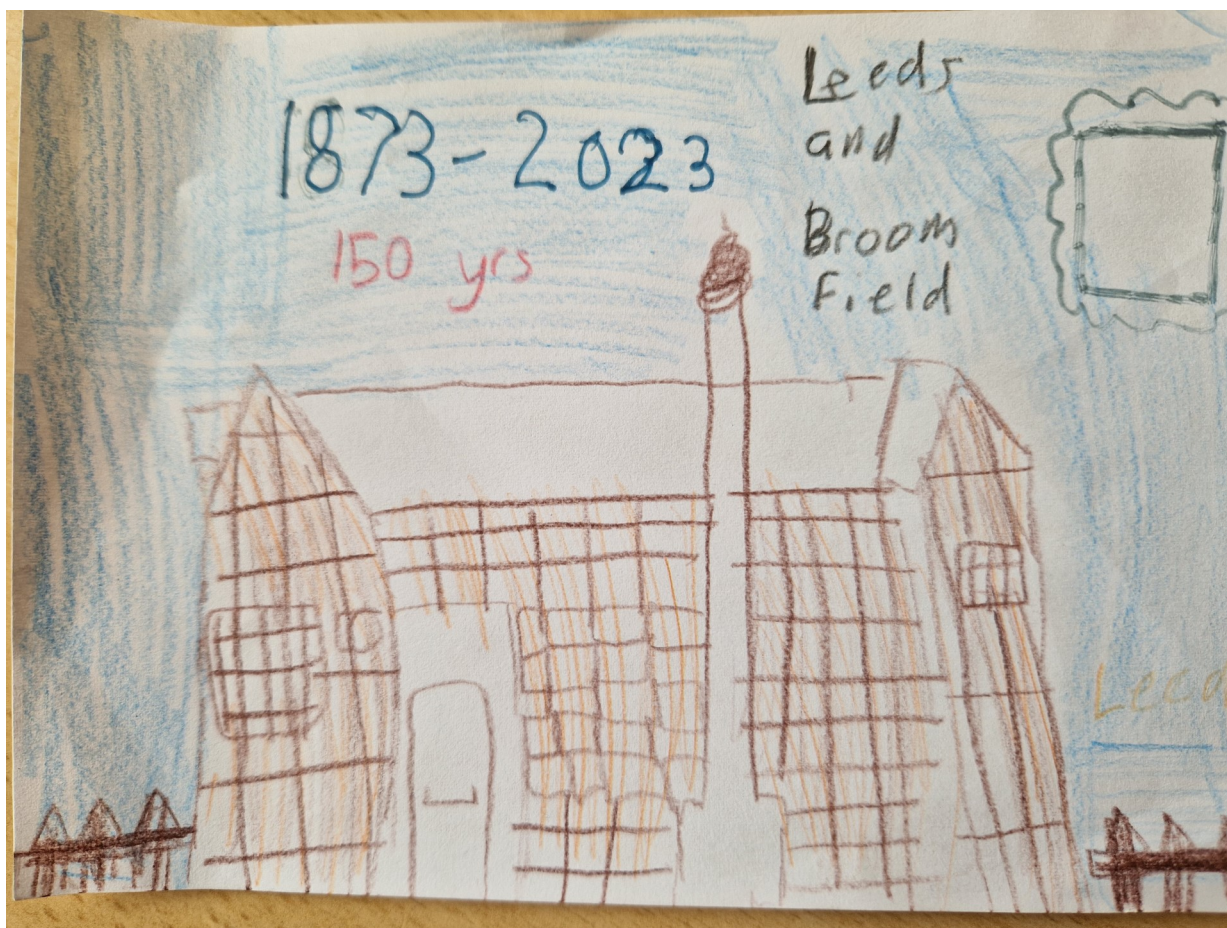
Term 5 ends— 26th May
