On Sunday last week it was Pentecost.

It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and other disciples following the Crucifixion, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus Christ (Acts of the Apostles, chapter 2), and it marks the beginning of the Christian church's mission to the world.

What could you share with people over the weekend?

Hedgehogs - have been introduced to their new film theme of the Little Mermaid. The children are very excited and are looking forward to seeing where their learning goes next.

Squirrels - Have been learning about the artist Henri Rousseau. They have explored different rainforests using paint.
