This year, the tests are due to take place on Thursday 7 September 2023 at their primary school.

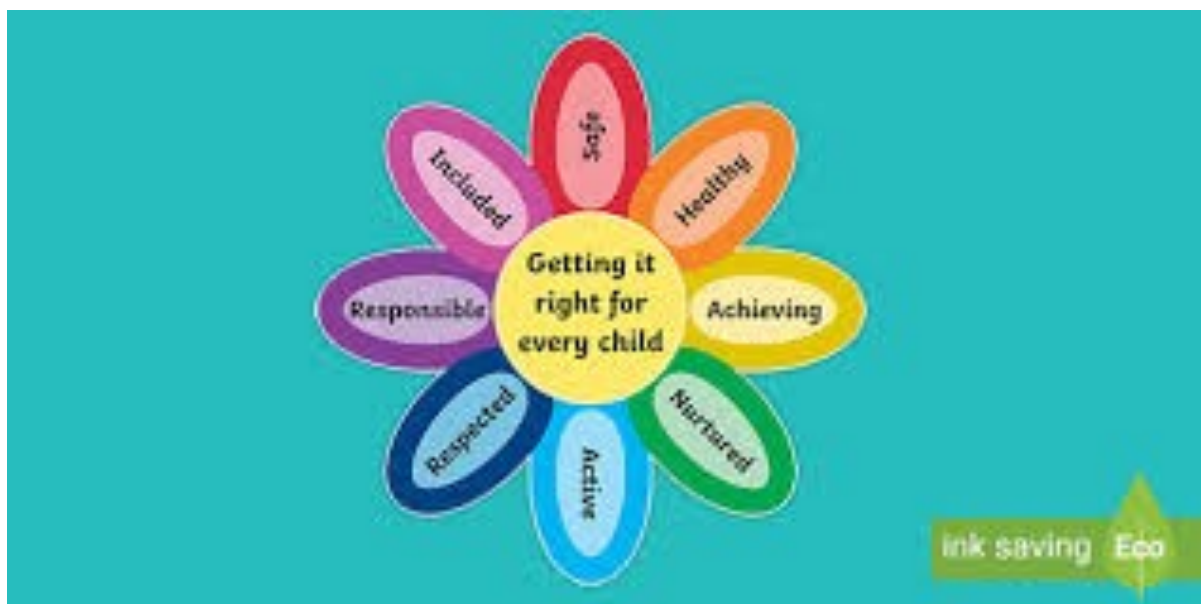
