Foxes— In maths they have been looking at partitioning numbers using the part part whole model. Talk to you child about two digit number. How many tens and ones?

Squirrels - - Are working their way through their class text, 'The owl who was afraid of the dark'. The children have been thoroughly engaged in the text and exploring new vocabulary.

Badgers - Have been learning to play rugby. The children have been learning the basic rules and learning to throw backwards and run forwards.
