- ◆ **Please do not park in the entrance to the car park - there will be little wooden people sat there to prevent parking. Parking here is dangerous for all.**


- ◆ **When the car park is at capacity - parents park down the middle. This does block people in but believe me the car park empties as quick as it fills.**
