

Give a running commentary. Talk about what you and your child are doing throughout the day, such as when you are on the bus, out for a walk or in the supermarket. Try to reduce the amount of questions you ask your child. Instead tell them about things.

### Online Safety Top Tip

Chat to your child about what they like to do online. The best way to find out what your child is doing online is to talk to them and have regular conversations so that online safety is part of everyday discussion. Ask them open-ended questions like, "What's your favourite game or app to play on?"
