This week the 106th archbishop of Canterbury is Dame **Sarah Mullally**, who was confirmed on 28 January 2026 and is the first woman to hold the office.

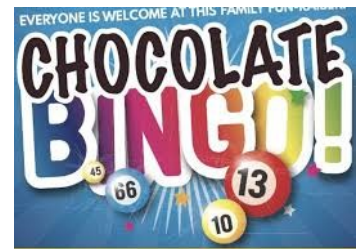
School returns on Monday 20th April.

Speech and Language Top Tip of the Week

Break Down Instructions: Instead of a long list of instructions, break requests into small, step-by-step chunks.

Hedgehogs - this week we have been looking at how to use our voices and dynamics when storytelling, creating voices for the wolf and the three little pigs. We have also been learning about Brazil and writing facts.



Foxes— this week we have been writing newspaper reports about Theseus and the Minotaur, we have also been planning and making our models of the Parthenon and have been learning about the lifestyle and education of the Ancient Greeks.

Squirrels - this week we looked at Maya numbers and did maths problems using them. We also looked at why the Maya declined. In English we did lots of work using thesauruses this week, really refining our writing. We looked at how everyone can spread Christian values in understanding beliefs, looking at people with disabilities who still help others around the world.

Badgers - this week we have been looking at Maya folk tales so that we can write our own. We have been looking at how they farmed as well as the role the gods played in their lives. Story writing begins next week!

Online Safety Top Tip—Roblox

Talking to Strangers

Being an online game means that players in Roblox can interact and communicate with each other in various ways. This can be via voice or written text once friend requests have been made. The risk of contact with strangers can be reduced by using private servers. Private servers allow your child to play games only with invited friends, preventing strangers from joining the session. Some games require users to pay to create a private server, while others allow players to create private servers for free.

Make sure your child understands that:

- They should never share personal information like their address, school or anything else (even if the person says they live in a different country)
 - Some people are not who they say they are, so it's better to be cautious
- They can come to you if they have any questions or concerns (and you will respond calmly and without judgement)
- There are signs that someone might be targeting them for grooming, scams or other issues
- They can and should make use of the in-game reporting and blocking features if someone makes them uncomfortable
