Speech and Language Top Tip of the Week

The power of 10 seconds

Giving your child extra time to process language and respond is one of the most effective ways to boost their communication confidence and skills.

After asking a question, making a comment or providing an instruction, wait at least 5-10 seconds before speaking again.

Online Safety Top Tip—Gaming online

Manage Communication: In privacy settings, restrict voice chat, messaging and party invitations to “Friends Only” or “No One” to avoid toxic users.
