A termly challenge.

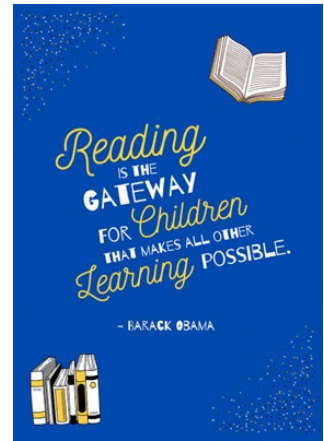
5 pupils from each class get a non-school uniform day - includes hair down.

Reading includes - following a recipe, magazines, comics, book, non fiction texts etc.

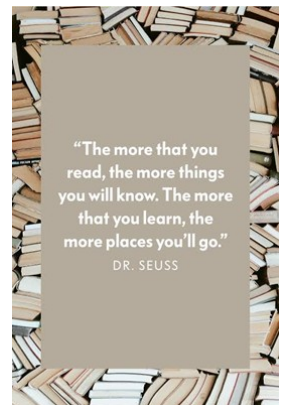
